- e. To forward to me all of the funds received from the purchase of the property, after payment of attorney fees to my attorney;
- f. To do all acts that I might or could have done in the purchase of the property.

2. **Takes Effect Regardless of Disability.** This Power of Attorney is effective now and remains in effect even if I become disabled or incapacitated.
